The Mount Forest Family Health Team, located in the north end of Wellington County offers health care professionals the opportunity to work in an interprofessional team dedicated to providing evidence informed primary care and health promotion to over 12,000 patients who live and work in Mount Forest and the surrounding rural communities.

We are currently seeking a full time (37.5 hours per week, Monday to Friday) Same Day Access Nurse Practitioner for a 9 month contract. Position salary is dependent upon experience. The Nurse Practitioner (NP) works collaboratively with allied health professionals including physicians, other nurse practitioners, registered nurses, pharmacist, dietitian, therapists, occupational therapist and health promoter. The NP will support patient care and work within the physician team. The NP will report to the Executive Director of the Mount Forest FHT.

The Same Day Access Nurse Practitioner provides care to patients of all ages with a focus on seniors, end of life, mental health, addictions and social determinants of health and:

- Provides comprehensive assessment and diagnosis of medical, functional, cognitive and behavioural issues of patients of all ages who are rostered to Mount Forest physicians
- Develops, coordinates and implements plans of care including health education, coaching and emotional support
- Partners with patients and families to ensure their priorities and needs are being addressed by the health care team
- Makes referrals to specialist physicians, allied health providers, community health and social services according to the needs of patients
- Initiates, coordinates, attends and participates in care conferences as needed

Education and knowledge required:

- Current member in good standing with the College of Nurses of Ontario extended class, primary care designation with no practice restrictions, minimum 3 years' experience
- Knowledge and proficiency in current, evidenced-based methods and practices of primary care delivery, with an emphasis on health promotion, risk reduction and chronic disease management
- Knowledge of client-centered philosophy, change management, basic principles and practices of community service delivery, short-term treatment options and chronic disease management models
- Advanced proficiency in computer use and various software applications including electronic medical records system – PS Suite preferred
