

COVID-19 Vaccine Drive Thru

Location: 29 David St. W. Elora, Ontario N0B 1S0

Date/Time: Will be given to you by your family doctor

What do I need to bring to my appointment?

- Health Card
- Mask

How do I prepare for my appointment?

- Take all your regular medication and eat your meals as usual on the day of your appointment
- Wear a loose-fitting top or a t-shirt so that the health care provider can easily access your upper arm for the vaccination
- If you have Symptoms of COVID-19, you should not attend the clinic, call your MRP for more instructions
- Do not arrive more than **5 MINUTES** before your appointment to avoid crowding

What can I expect when I arrive for my appointment?

- This is a drive thru vaccination clinic, and you will remain in your vehicle the entire time. There will be clearly marked signs and people to direct you to the areas that you will need to go.
- Upon arrival you will be screened and checked in; **Please have your Health card ready in hand**
- After being checked in you will be directed to the vaccination area where you will receive your vaccine. Upon receiving your vaccine, you will be **REQUIRED** to wait **15 MINUTES** post vaccination.
- After your 15 minutes you can be checked out. Please note that a printed copy of your vaccination **WILL NOT** be available and will be emailed to you for your records.

What happens after my Vaccine?

- Most vaccines except Johnson & Johnson is a 2-dose vaccine. We will arrange a second dose in 3-4 months.
DO NOT call the office asking when your second shot will be.
We will call you as soon as we have that information.
- If you experience any reactions to the vaccine call your doctor for further instructions
